



iPad Insurance Coverage

PRICING

- ❖ 2016-2017 School Year Premium: **\$70**
- ❖ Incident Deductible: **\$50 – Same deductible for any and all incidents**

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- ❖ Students must keep iPad in provided GumDrop case at all times
- ❖ Any damage to iPad that occurs when iPad is not in case will not be covered by the insurance and the cost of the damage will be the responsibility of the student
- ❖ Insurance Premium must be paid for student to take iPad home
- ❖ Breaks must be reported immediately to a teacher

WHAT IS COVERED?

- ❖ **Accidental Coverage**
 - Cracked Screens or general body damage
 - Hardware malfunction
 - Liquid Spills
 - Non-Malicious Damage
- ❖ **Lost or Stolen Coverage**
 - Discounted replacement for Lost Devices: \$100
 - Discounted replacement for Stolen Devices w/Police Report: \$100

WHAT ISN'T COVERED?

- ❖ Damage due to malice or neglect
 - All neglect or malicious damage decisions are made on a case-by-case basis by the staff Tech Committee

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DAMAGE MY DEVICE?

- ❖ Student will notify teacher immediately and file a claim using the online form explaining how the damage occurred to the device. Teacher takes iPad. *This form initiates the insurance process*
- ❖ Technology Committee reviews all suspected neglect or malicious damage cases at next meeting
- ❖ Repaired or replacement iPad will be given to student within 7 days of deductible payment
