



### **SUMMER SCHOOL 2019**

**Tuesday, May 28-Friday, July 12 (Off July 1- July 5 for Independence Day)**

#### **Registration Dates:** April 1-May 17

Completed summer school registration paperwork and payments must be delivered to Ms. Otero or Guidance by the May 17 deadline. **ALL** registration materials (paperwork and payment) *must* be submitted at the same time; no exceptions. #### **Course Cost:** Student limited to 1 course unless approved by Ms. Scannell.

- Physical Education: \$30 per session
- Health: \$60
- Personal Finance: \$60
- Spanish 3: \$60
- Government/Econ: \$60
- Summer English Bridge Program: \$60
- Credit Recovery: \$100

#### **Student Policies:**

- Students are expected to adhere to rules and regulations as defined in the HAST Student Handbook.
- Students who fail a course will receive a failing grade on their official transcript.
- Students do not need to wear uniforms, but are expected to wear clothing that is appropriate for a school setting.
- Disciplinary action may extend into the 2019-20 school year per Indiana State Due Process Code.
- Only students enrolled in Summer School at HAST will be allowed on school property.
- Attendance Policy- Students will fail the course and fail to earn credit for excessive absences. No refunds.
  - Government & Economics, Physical Education, Spanish 3, and English Bridge:
    - Upon 4th absence
    - Upon 4th tardy
    - Combination of absences and tardies totaling 4
  - Online Health & Personal Finance:
    - Upon 2nd absence
    - Upon 2nd tardy
    - Combination of absences and tardies totaling 2
  - Credit Recovery:
    - No Attendance Policy; Open Lab: Monday-Friday from 8AM-12PM



### **Physical Education- All Grade Levels**

***Monday- Friday***

***Session 1: 8AM- 10AM***

***Session 2: 10AM- 12PM***

This class is designed for students that have not fulfilled their physical education graduation requirement. Students will need to purchase a PE uniform and will be expected to wear it. Class will be held both indoors and outdoors, so plan accordingly (water, sunscreen, etc.). Please indicate which session your student will be attending. One semester of PE credit will be awarded upon the successful completion of this course. Students who successfully complete Sessions 1 & 2 will earn two PE credits.

### **Health (Online)- All Grade Levels**

***In Person: Thursday 12PM- 2PM***

This class is designed for students that have not fulfilled their health graduation requirement. Students will be guided in weekly online assignments that are designed for successful completion of the course. Computers will be provided during class, but students will need a working, Internet-connected computer outside of HAST in order to complete online assignments. Students are required to meet with the instructor once a week to take course assessments and ensure that they are on track. One semester of health credit will be awarded upon the successful completion of this course.

### **Personal Finance (Online)- Only for Grades 10, 11, and 12**

***In Person: Tuesday 12PM- 2PM***

This class is designed for students that have not fulfilled their personal finance graduation requirement. Students will be guided in weekly online assignments that are designed for successful completion of the course. Computers will be provided during class, but students will need a working, Internet-connected computer outside of HAST in order to complete online assignments. Students are required to meet with the instructor once a week to take course assessments and ensure that they are on track. One semester of personal finance credit will be awarded upon the successful completion of this course.

### **Credit Recovery (Online)- All Grade Levels**

***Monday-Friday 8AM- 12PM, Open Lab***

Students taking credit recovery courses will be using online content in place of traditional textbooks. A teacher will be present in the room, but students are expected to work independently. Students will attend classes until they have successfully completed their course requirement. All credit recovery tests must be completed at the school. Although no attendance is taken, it is important to note that students who attend regularly for the full 4 hours are much more likely to complete their courses on time.

**Spanish 3- Open to students who have successfully completed Spanish 2*****Monday- Friday 8AM-12 PM***

This class will be a combination of online coursework and in-class instruction. Students are expected to attend class for the full 4 hours each day. Failure to complete the course will result in a failing grade. Two semesters of Spanish 3 credit will be awarded upon the successful completion of this course.

**Government & Economics- Only open to ACC students (Grades 11 & 12)*****Monday-Friday 8AM-12PM***

This class is only opened to students who have been approved to attend the ACC during the 2019-20 School Year. This class will be a combination of online coursework and in-class instruction. Students are expected to attend class for the full 4 hours each day. Failure to complete the course will result in a failing grade. Upon completion of these courses, students will earn 1 credit for U.S. Government and 1 credit for Economics (both are graduation requirements).

**Summer English Bridge Program- Only open to incoming Grade 9 Students*****Monday-Friday 8AM-12PM***

This class is open to incoming 9th grade students. This class will be a combination of online coursework and in-class instruction. It is designed to help build the English skills to be successful in high school. Students are expected to attend class for the full 4 hours each day. Failure to complete the course will result in a failing grade. Upon completion of the course, students will earn 1 English credit.

*\*Please Note: Any course is subject to cancellation if there are not enough students registered by the May 17, 2019 deadline! If the course you sign up for gets cancelled, then you will receive a credit towards your HAST fees for the upcoming school year.\**
