Dear Parents/Guardians:

School City of Hammond believes that feeding our students is an essential function during continuity of operations. While our school buildings are closed, the Department of Food and Nutrition will provide an opportunity for families to pick up lunch and breakfast for the following day in a mobile walk up or drive-thru meal service for children 18 and under. We will be providing meals over the week of Spring Break as well (March 23rd – 27th). **This will occur at six sites across the School City of Hammond from 11:30am – 12:30pm Monday through Friday at the main door of each school building listed below:**

- **Edison Elementary School** - 7025 Madison Avenue, Hammond, IN 46324
- **Franklin Elementary School** - 1000 116th Street, Whiting, IN 46394
- **Harding Elementary School** - 3211 165th Street, Hammond, IN 46323
- **Irving Elementary School** - 4727 Pine Avenue, Hammond, IN 46327
- **Maywood Elementary School** - 1001 165th Street, Hammond, IN 46324
- **Morton Elementary School** - 7006 Marshall Avenue, Hammond, IN 46323

These meals will be available for free for anyone 18 and under regardless of what school they attend. No paperwork is required. Children must be present in order for meals to be provided and the meals will be provided based on the number of children present. Please note that it is the individual family's responsibility to monitor for food allergies during this time.

This program will be solely for the pickup of meals, and meals will not be consumed on-site. We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site and utilizing social distancing once meals have been distributed.

Estimados Padres/Guardianes:

Las escuelas públicas de la ciudad de Hammond creen que alimentar a nuestros estudiantes es una función esencial durante la continuidad de las operaciones. Durante este tiempo, mientras nuestros edificios están cerrados, el Departamento de Alimentos y Nutrición proporcionará una oportunidad para que las familias recojan el almuerzo y el desayuno para el día siguiente por medio de un servicio móvil de comida para niños de 18 años o menos. Proporcionaremos comidas durante la semana de vacaciones de primavera (del 23 al 27 de marzo). **Esto ocurrirá en seis sitios a través de la Ciudad Escolar de Hammond de 11:30am – 12:00pm de lunes a viernes en las puertas principales de cada edificio que se encuentra anotada en esta carta.**

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Estas comidas estarán disponibles de forma gratuita para cualquier persona de 18 años o menos e independientemente de la escuela a la que asistan. No se requiere papeleo. Los niños deben estar presentes para que se proporcionen comidas. Las comidas se proporcionarán en función del número de niños presentes. Tenga en cuenta que es responsabilidad de cada familia controlar las alergias alimentarias durante este tiempo.

Este programa será únicamente para la recogida de comidas, y las comidas no se consumirán en el sitio. Alentamos a las familias a seguir siendo proactivas en la reducción del riesgo de COVID-19 al no congregarse en el sitio de la escuela y utilizar el distanciamiento social una vez que se han distribuido las comidas.

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
